


Outcomes from a 5050 TWI Program in California

- This program has been in operation for over 7 years, so its students are in middle school
- Background Information on Students:
 - 50% ELL, 50% EP
 - Of ELL: 83% on free lunch
 - Of EP: 11% on free lunch; 14% Latino & 81% Anglo
- Remember -- in interpreting norm-referenced tests, NCEs of 45 55 represent grade-level scores.




The students ²⁵ made good growth in developing proficiency in ¹⁶ English.



Reading Achievement Assessed in Spanish (SABE2)


TWI vs. District vs. State

- FEP and ELL students scored average to very high.
- FEP scored the highest.
- EP students scored average after 3rd grade.
- They scored equal to or higher than the state average.







Previous ELLs - TWI vs. District vs. State

At Grade Level






Reading Achievement Assessed in English (CAT6)


English Proficient (EP) - TWI vs. District vs. State

 EP students scored above average and higher than state and district averages for English speakers learning only in English.




English Language Arts California Standards Test

English Proficient (EP) - TWI vs. District vs. State




English Language Arts California Standards Test - 2005 English Language Learners (ELL)






California Standards Test -- English Language Arts ELL & FEP Students Combined

- At all grade levels, especially 6th, students outscored their ELL peers in the state.







English Math (CAT6) Previous ELL Students

Below Average to Grade Level




FEP Students
At to Above Grade Level






English Math (CAT6) English Speakers


- English speakers scored high.
- EP students significantly outscored the state and district English speakers learning only in English.




Mathematics California Standards Test - 2005

English Proficient (EP)






Mathematics California Standards Test - 2005 English Language Learners (ELL)
