Principle 3

□ Teachers involve every student in authentic, challenging, and engaging academic experiences, including tasks that prompt them to use critical thinking skills that relate to their experiences.

- □ Timeline is an activity in which students are given signs that represent either steps in a cycle or historic events.

Engaging with Parents Virtually

- Seesaw and other platforms have parent engagement tools with translation.
- □ Inviting parents to be "Zoom Room Parents" with assigned roles (attendance, moderating chats, adding links, pressing record, etc.)
- Encouraging multi-lingual home activities by asking students to interview family members, read or play games in L1, or analyze when each language is used and for what purpose.
